



OEHHA Adds Aloe Vera, Non-Decolorized Whole Leaf Extract and Goldenseal Root Powder to List of Cancer-Causing Chemicals Under California Prop 65

California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) [announced](#) that effective December 4, 2015, "*Aloe vera*, non-decolorized whole leaf extract and Goldenseal root powder" will be added to the list of chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer for purposes of California's Proposition 65 ("Prop 65"). According to OEHHA, "*Aloe vera*, non-decolorized whole leaf extract consists of the liquid portion of the *Aloe vera* leaf and is a natural constituent of the *Aloe barbadensis* Millerplant." OEHHA also specifies that "Goldenseal root powder is a natural constituent of the goldenseal plant (*Hydrastis Canadensis*)". Read the Client Alert [here](#).
