



Ohio Amends Law on Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care

Governor John Kasich signed Ohio Substitute House Bill 126 (“Sub. H.B. 126”), effective March 20, 2014, implementing various amendments to the Ohio law governing durable power of attorney for health care. Most notably, Sub.
