



## Ohio EPA's New Guidance Raises Stakes on Vapor Intrusion

**SEPTEMBER 2016**

On August 24, Ohio EPA released new guidance that incorporates an unprecedented approach to vapor intrusion. Under the new guidance, *Recommendations Regarding Response Action Levels and Timeframes for Common Contaminants of Concern at Vapor Intrusion Sites in Ohio*, the Agency is for the first time demanding immediate action when contaminant levels exceed certain established “trigger” levels. In the case of one particular contaminant – trichloroethylene (TCE) – the Agency expects action within days if the associated trigger levels are exceeded.
