



Supreme Court of Ohio Upholds Enforceability of “Pay-if-Paid” Provisions Between Contractors and Subcontractors

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On July 17, 2014, the Supreme Court of Ohio reaffirmed the enforceability of “pay-if-paid” provisions in construction contracts. These provisions condition payment from the general contractor to its subcontractor on the receipt of payment from the owner.
